



## **Product Types**

Straight Purge Assemblies Connecting the Inlet (auxiliary) port of the regulator or in between the regulator and the cylinder to allow the corrosive or toxic gas to be vented through to a safe location.


Tee Purge Assemblies Connecting the cylinder with the regulator, allowing process gas flowing through to purge out the remaining contamination in between the cylinder and the regulator to prevent the high purity gas system from atmospheric contamination.













Cross Purge Assemblies Connecting the cylinder and the regulator with an additional shutoff diaphragm valve to the Tee Purge Assemblies to utilize inert gas from the outside to purge out the contamination in between the cylinder and the regulator.
